

This is to certify that that all substances, preparations and articles used in the manufacture of the modcon® series are in compliance with the Restriction of Hazardous Substance (RoHS) following directives:

## EU directive 2011/65/UE (RoHS)

The EU's RoHS directive bans the use of a number of poisonous substances in electrical products from 8st of June 2011. Chemicals, elements or substances are:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBBs)
- Polybrominated Diphenyls (PBDEs)

The EU's RoHS directive bans from 1st of July 2008 the use of Decabromdiphenylether (DecaBDE), according to decision by the EC Court of Justice, April 1st, 2008.

## EU directive 2006/122/EG

The EU's directive bans from 27th of June 2008 the use in electrical products:

- Perfluorooctane sulfonates (PFOS).
