

RoHS DECLARATION

On 22.07.2019 the amendment 2015/863 of RoHS Directive (Restrictions on the use of Hazardous Substances in electric and electronic Equipment) 2011/65 will become effective.

With this amendment the list of banned substances will increase from 6 Substances to 10 and will now be as follows:

Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	22/07/2019	0.10%
